- Incomplete grades or failed courses
- Added courses after the first registration schedule's tuition has been paid
- Classes that are not part of the degree's curriculum
- Excess enrollment fees (scholarship restricted to six (6) consecutive semester enrollment)
- Parking decals or campus traffic violations
- Membership dues for clubs and organizations
- Photo I.D. renewals
- Miscellaneous school supplies, i.e. notebooks, folders, USBs, etc.

The Black Hospitality Initiative will suspend or terminate this scholarship if the above terms are not met. Scholarships will be forfeited if two (2) consecutive school semesters are missed. Exceptions due to family emergencies will be considered.
